London-Waterloo to Weybridge

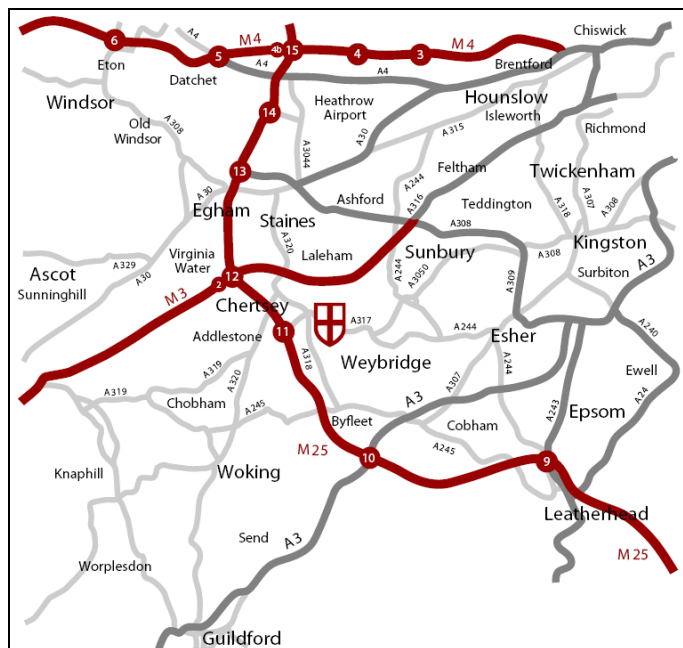
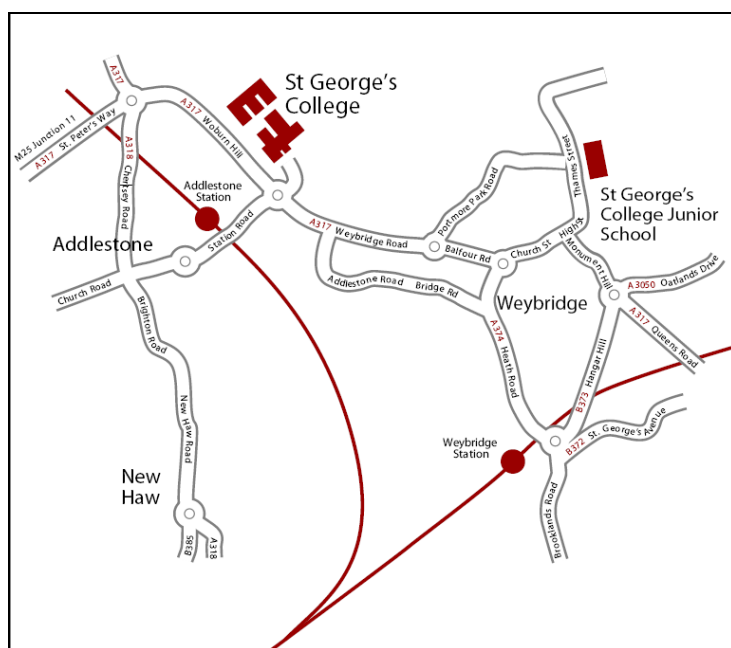
